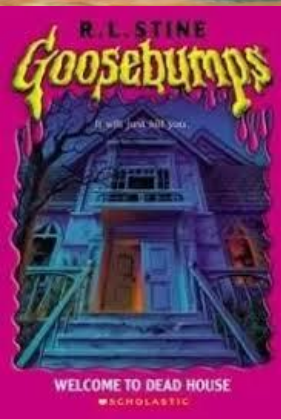


Y4 - Term 3
